



# Certified Application Counselor (CAC) Certification Requirements

## The Benefits:

You and/or your staff will be able to help Connecticut residents with assessing their eligibility and facilitating their enrollment into Medicaid (HUSKY), the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), or Qualified Health Plans.

## Access Health CT will certify participation in the CAC Program, if the following requirements are met:

All participants in the Program must complete the online Certification Program and earn a passing score of at least 80% on the Examination.

CACs and their sponsoring organizations must sign the Certified Application Counselor Program Policies & Agreements.

## Organizations must fall into one of these categories:

- Federally Qualified Health Centers
- Hospitals
- Issuers
- Municipalities
- Healthcare Provider Organizations\*

*\*especially Community Mental Health Centers and organizations on AHCT's list of Essential Community Providers*
